

SUDDEN DEATH

In the event the Tie-Breaker results in another tie, then a Sudden Death Round will be played. Read the following instructions to the teams before beginning the round.

SUDDEN DEATH INSTRUCTIONS:

In this round, up to 7 Sudden Death tie-breaker questions will be asked to both teams at the same time. These questions are selected from the practice questions. **Team members may NOT confer about answers. Each team member must write his/her own answer on an index card.** Team members will be moved away from each other so as not to be able to see someone else's card. **For this round, a correct answer will be just the book title (including all articles); no author's name is required.**

You will have 30 seconds to write down your answer, with a 10-second time warning. (40 seconds total) Team members must stop writing when the Timekeeper announces time is up. The Scorekeeper/Timekeeper will collect the cards from both teams. *(Note: Be careful to keep each team's cards separate.)*

The Question Reader will announce the correct answer to the question and then read aloud the answers collected from the first team, and the score will be tallied. Then the Question Reader will read aloud the answers collected from the second team and the scorekeeper will tally that score. Incorrect spelling will not count off, as long as the answer is considered coherent to the average *person*. Each correct answer is worth 1 point. **The first team to be ahead in points during the Sudden Death Round will be declared the winner of the round** and will advance to the next round of competition.

Teams are reminded that a question cannot be repeated and there is no talking or conferring with other teammates whatsoever. Please make sure you keep your eyes on your own card.
