TIE-BREAKER INSTRUCTIONS

If the two teams are tied after their round, then a Tie-Breaker Round is held. Read the following instructions aloud to the two teams before beginning the Tie-Breaker Round.

TEAM INSTRUCTIONS FOR TIE-BREAKER ROUND

Since the preliminary round resulted in a tie, we will now hold a Tie-Breaker Round. Please listen carefully to the instructions for this round.

The same procedures will be followed as in the Preliminary Round, <u>except the questions will be from the new question set, not the practice questions.</u>
These are questions the students have not heard before. In this round, up to 7 tie-breaker questions will be asked to each team, one at a time. If the tie is broken after each team has had a turn, the match is over.

- If Team A gets its first new question correct, it will earn 5 points. If Team A misses the question, the question will be asked to Team B, for a possible 3 points.
- Team B will then be asked a new question. If team B gets its first new question correct, it will earn 5 points. If Team B misses the question, the question will be asked to Team A, for a possible 3 points.
- If the tie is broken after each team has had a turn, the match is over.
- If the teams are still tied, the questioner proceeds with a new question to each team. If both teams have been asked their second question and the tie is broken, the match is over. If the teams are still tied, the questioner proceeds to the third new question for each team.
- If the teams are tied at the end of the tie breaker round, they will proceed to sudden death.

The team that wins the Tie-Breaker Round will advance to the next round of competition.
